To say Kerr Lake is big is an understatement. Its over 850 miles of shoreline stretched across Vance County and the North Carolina/Virginia state line. Making it one of the largest lakes in the Southeast. It's also one of the most beautiful. From wooded shores to secluded coves to tranquil picnic areas.

Kerr Lake has long been known as a haven for boaters and skiers.

Sailboats and wind surfers cruise across endless expanses of water. While boaters and skiers glide across coves of glass-like water.

There are two marinas and numerous boat ramps for easy access to the lake. What's more, the marinas offer fishing equipment, fuel, repairs and more.

Also, there are several public swimming areas for you and your family to get your feet wet.

FEW CAMPS HAVE THESE SIGHTS.

The great outdoors are even greater at Kerr Lake. Campers can choose from seven state parks and over 700 campsites.

Set up camp on a secluded, pristine beach or beneath majestic, towering pines. Then sit back and watch the stars and the moon dance across the sky.

We've made roughing it a lot smoother. Each campsite has a picnic table, fire pit and tent pad. Modern rest rooms as well as hot showers are easily accessible. And electric and water hookups are available for recreational vehicles.

We also offer numerous picnic areas nestled along the waterfront. And there are large community buildings to accommodate group activities.
